## St. Jude Memphis to Peoria Run Facts

## About the St. Jude Memphis to Peoria Run:

> The Memphis to Peoria Run began in 1982 with 21 runners raising $\$ 22,550$
> 2024 will be the $43^{\text {rd }}$ annual Run
> In 2023, the Memphis to Peoria Runners alone raised \$1,313,632.00
> Memphis to Peoria Runners and Satellite Runners combined have raised \$82.1 million to date.
$>100 \%$ of every dollar donated to a runner goes towards research and care of children.
$>$ Unique charity relay-style running event.
$>$ Must be able to run 3-5 miles at a 10-minute mile pace in the heat.
$>$ Runners run 465 miles in total from Memphis, TN, to Peoria, IL, running 24 hours a day, rain or shine. Takes 4 days to complete.
> Expenses are covered by sponsorship money, not donations collected by the runners.
$>$ Each runner must raise $\$ 3,000$ to participate ( $\$ 2,500$ if immediate family member is participating) - most runners raise over \$4,000 each.
$>$ Donations are tax deductible and receipts are available upon request.
> Donor checks should be made payable to St. Jude Runs
> Donations over $\$ 250$ should be reported to the Run office for IRS purposes (forms for this purpose are available at www.stjuderuns.org).
